THE MEDIEVAL CITADEL OF SEVERIN

It was built in medieval times.
Its founder was King Ladislaus I (1040-1095).
It is a historical monument that is part of
National cultural heritage.
It was built as a fortress against the Pecenes and Cumanians
present in the region.



THEODOR COSTESCU THEATRE

His construction began in 1912 at the initiative of Theodor Costescu, Director of Traian High School in Drobeta. The first performance took place on November 30, 1924. It is a representative symbol of Severin, being declared a protected historical monument, on the UNESCO list.





THE KINETIC FOUNTAIN

It was inaugurated in 1979.
It is also known as "Hora de la Bălăcița".
It was made by Constantin Lucaci, one of the most remarkable stainless steel sculptors in the world.
It is a bold combination of water, lights, motion and stainless steel.





ROZELOR PARK

Rozelor Park in Drobeta Turnu Severin was arranged between 1911 and 1914.

An important landmark of Rozelor Park is the Monument of the Heroes, made by the sculptor Teodor Burca and the architect State Balosin. This monument was inaugurated on 4 June 1933 and is a tribute to the Romanian heroes fallen in the First World War.





IRON GATES MUSEUM


Year of foundation: 1882.

Main Profile: History, Daco-Roman Archeology, Natural Sciences, Aquarium, Botany, Ethnography, History, Zoology.

The museum building is declared a historic monument and was built in 1926.




TRAJAN'S BRIDGE RUINS

Trajan's Bridge was a bridge built by Apolodor from Damascus between the spring of 103 and the spring of 105 on the Lower Danube, east of the Iron Gates, in the city of Drobeta-Turnu Severin. The purpose of the construction was to facilitate the transport of the Romanian relatives led by Trajan and the supplies necessary for the second military campaign to conquer Dacia of King Decebal. Length 1135 m, Width 12 m, Height 46-50 m.

DROBETA ROMAN MILITARY CAMP

Drobeta was the first stone fortress built in Dacia (103-105) by Emperor Trajan, a Roman defense camp and an important military and political center, originally built to house 500 soldiers who guarded the bridge. You can see the foundations (rebuilt by Constantine the Great) on a two-hectare area with four gates, houses, barracks, arms, streets, and in the center of the fortress the building of the pretor (commander) where Emperor Trajan stayed in the winter of 105.

WATER CASTLE

It was built between 1910 and 1914.

The construction was given to the city by the Romanian King Carol I.

It is 27 meters high, with a diameter of about 10 meters, and in the upper part it has 4 towers. It is the tallest building in Drobeta.

Today, the building houses a tourist information center, an exhibition space and an art gallery, a "history of water supply in Drobeta Turnu Severin", a photo and sculpture exhibition, a literary café and a viewing area.





CRIȘAN PROMENADE

The Crişan promenade area includes Crişan Street between Tudor Vladimirescu Blvd. and Revolution Blvd. December 18-22, 1989. The area is closed to the traffic of motor vehicles, being heavily circulated by children and young people. The green area around the promenade forms a beautiful park with benches, an arbor and playgrounds for children. In the immediate vicinity you can find "Drobeta" Skating Rink and the Olympic Basin.

DROBETA TURNU SEVERIN HARBOR

Drobeta Turnu Severin Harbor is a Romanian river harbor built on the left bank of the Danube between km 930 and 934. It has passenger and freight transport facilities. In the area of the harbour there is a small sea front on the Danube

and a few terraces.





THE DANUBE DEFILE

The Danube Defile is located between Moldova Nouă and Gura Văii, the most picturesque part being Orşova and "Cazanele Dunării", located on the Eşelniţa and Dubova localities. "Cazanele" are divided - coming from Orşova - into the "Cazanele Mici" (on the Eşelniţa ray), in the middle of the picturesque valley of Mraconia, dominated by the rocky bust of King Decebal and "Cazanele Mari", beyond the Gulf of Dubova, dominated by the heights of "Ciucarul Mare".





DECEBAL'S STATUE

Decebal's face is a rock sculpture on the Danube, located between Eşelniţa and Dubova, near Orşova.

It is the largest stone carving in Europe. The works took place between 1994 and 2004. It has a total height of 55 meters, 6 meters less than the Statue of Liberty and 8 meters more than the Monument of Christ in Rio de Janeiro. The construction lasted 10 years and cost over \$1 million.





THE IRON GATE I HYDROELECTRIC POWER **STATION**

The Iron Gate I Hydroelectric Power Station is the largest in Romania, producing 50% of the country's hydropower. It transforms the hydraulic energy into electricity. It is one of the largest hydrotechnical constructions in Europe. The construction of the dam project began in 1964. The hydro power station includes a museum, inaugurated in 1976. In Turbine Hall you will admire the six Kaplan turbines, each with a capacity of 194.5 MW and a weight of 3680t.





VODIȚA MONASTERY

Vodiţa is a monastery located on the valley of Vodita river (about 1 km upstream of the mouth of the Danube), about 15 km west of Drobeta-Turnu Severin. It is among the first monasteries documented in Wallachia, being raised at the expense of voivode Vladislav I (Vlaicu Voda), at the suggestion and effort of the monk Nicodim between 1369-1374.

SFÂNTA ANA MONASTERY

Sfânta Ana Monastery is 1.5 km away south of the town of Orşova, on the hill of "Dealul Moşului".

The monastery was founded by the great journalist Pamfil Şeicaru (1894-1980) as a thank-you to God for saving his life during the struggles here, in the summer and autumn of 1916.

The construction of the monastery took place between 1936-1939, following a project by architect Ştefan Petemeli.





TOPOLNIȚA MONASTERY

Topolniţa Monastery is an old Orthodox monastery in the Episcopate of Severin and Strehaia. Located on the top of the Topolniţa river valley between the villages of Schitul de Jos and Schitul de Sus in Izvoru Bârzii commune, the old Topolniţa Monastery is only 20 km away from Drobeta Turnu Severin. The old church of the Topolniţa Monastery was founded by the Craioveşti boyars in the 16th century on the hearth of an older church built by Saint Nicodim, the founder of the Tismana and Vodiţa monasteries.





MRACONIA MONASTERY

It was built in 1523.

His founder was the banner of Severin, Nicolae Gârlişteanu.

It was destroyed during the Russo-Austro-Turkish War (1787-1792), being later rebuilt and demolished by the Communist regime in 1967. After 1989, the Metropolitan of Oltenia took the initiative to reestablish the Mraconia Monastery, so that in 1993 the foundation stone of the new church was laid, and in 1995 the settlement was reestablished - the works were finished in 1999-2000.

OPRIȘOR WINERY

In January 2000, Carl Reh Winery became the owner of Oprisor Winery. Step by step,the "Amphitheater" of "Golului Drincei" is replanted with vineyards, covering an area of 250 hectares. In the spring of 2001, Carl Reh Winery launched the first editions of the VAL DUNA and LA CETATE brands on the domestic market.

2008 has brought an important identity change. It was the time for OPRIŞOR Winery to take over and, in the spirit of the father-son relationship, to carry on, developing it, above all, towards the deep values of Oltenia.





CORCOVA WINERY

Thanks to the gentle Mediterranean climate, viticulture is practiced in from Dacian times. The first documentary attestation of the vineyard is made in a charter in 1497, when Radu the Great gives to Tismana Monastery wine from Jidoştiţa.

The name of Corcova is mentioned in 1594, by an act issued by Mihai Viteazul, who gave two vineyards to a boyar in the village. The vineyard has gradually grown to reach 55 hectares in 2010, of which 40 are only varieties for red wine.





STÂRMINA WINERY

At Stârmina, Turnu Severin, in Mehedinţi County, the company Vinarte has a total of 190 hectares. In 2009, an extensive program of modernization of winemaking technologies was completed. Due to its position in the southwestern region of the country, in the immediate vicinity of the Danube, with a climate that benefits from the Mediterranean influence, this vineyard has always produced remarkable wines. Vines are specially designed to produce wines of great character, both red and white.





KLADOVO, SERBIA

"Vis-a-vis" from Drobeta-Turnu Severin is Kladovo, a cozy city, ideal for one day or even a few hours visit.

The city with only 9.142 inhabitants has a well-developed pedestrian area with taverns, cafes and small shops.

You can stroll along the lakes and through the very well-kept park at the entrance and on the beach.

Kladovo Harbor looks good and is always full of boats.
